

# Construction update

Works are continuing on the Echuca-Moama Bridge Project.

## What we're doing and when

### Stage 3

Construction of the new bridge over the Murray River is well underway and we've cast more than 30 of the 43 concrete bridge segments that will span the waterway, connecting Victoria and NSW.

In September, we'll:

- continue building the main bridge span over the Murray River
- install concrete barriers and pour concrete for the approach span in Moama
- finish installing barriers on the bridge over the Campaspe River in Echuca.

### Stage 4

We've completed the connection of new stormwater pipes to Francis Street. We've also finished the temporary widening works, which included shifting traffic lanes for the Cobb Highway and Perricoota Road intersection.

In September, we'll continue:

- installing the new stormwater pipes along Perricoota Road
- works to complete the access to the Moama Marketplace loading dock
- constructing the new Meninya Street intersection.

The timing of these works may change depending on weather and site conditions.

Some works such as concrete pours may need to be undertaken out-of-hours. If this needs to happen near you, we'll let you know in advance.

All works will take place from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **7am to 1pm, Saturdays**.

## Changes for river users

Until early November 2021, there'll be changes in place on the Murray River and near the Victoria Park boat ramp.

Vessel operators are advised to exercise caution when navigating and to pay attention to signage and buoyage near our works. Transport for NSW (Maritime) has introduced a four (4) knot speed limit while these changes are in place.

## Safety is our key priority

The Echuca-Moama Bridge Project has been designated a critical state infrastructure project under the latest restrictions. Work is continuing safely with strict COVIDSafe plans in place and we'll continue to comply with all directions from the Chief Health Officer.

We are managing the number of staff attending our worksites, as well as implementing preventative measures to ensure community safety.

Safety measures across the site include temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.
