

Early works are underway on the Pound Road West upgrade

From September we'll start removing informal parking on Remington Drive, install barriers to protect motorists and pedestrians from construction machinery, and create a safe environment for construction workers.

We'll also put in place no-go zones for vegetation we'll protect during construction activities, and continue with service locating works on Remington Drive and Pound Road West.

From October we'll remove trees along Remington Drive and adjacent to the rail line to make way for the new lanes and safety barriers.

What we're doing and when

Along Remington Drive we'll:

- start removing informal parking along both sides of Remington Drive
- install temporary barriers and "no standing" signs
- reduce the speed limit to 40km/hr for the duration of construction

- install fencing around vegetation which has been identified to be retained
- install construction fencing and signage around work areas
- temporarily widen some driveways to accommodate b-double and semitrailer access to businesses.

Along Remington Drive and Pound Road West, including intersecting roads, we will also be undertaking surveying to locate underground services.

From Wednesday 1 September until Friday 3 September line marking along Remington Drive will take place at night between 7pm and 6am.

How these works may affect you

From September there will be changed traffic conditions on Remington Drive. Speeds will be reduced to 40km/hr. If you're driving, walking or cycling near any of our work sites, please take notice of road signage and follow traffic controllers' instructions.

Our construction activities will at times generate medium levels of noise, dust and vibration. We'll ensure any impacts are kept to a minimum.

We'll maintain access to private property and businesses at all times.
