# MORDIALLOC FREEWAY



## We're building the Mordialloc Freeway to connect the Mornington Peninsula Freeway to the Dingley Bypass.

We've wasted no time getting back to work after the festive season and have made strong progress as we continue building the new Freeway.

### In the past month, we've:

- started installing the fences next to Braeside Park to help minimise impacts to local wildlife
- finished installing the piles to help support the bridge over Centre Dandenong Road
- upgraded the Wells Road and Thames Promenade intersection, replacing the roundabout with traffic lights.

Thank you for your patience while we completed these important works.

### In February, we'll:

- install the beams for the Freeway bridge over Centre Dandenong Road

- finish installing the piles for the twin bridges over the Waterways wetlands at Mordialloc Creek
- continue building the new entry and exit ramps at Thames Promenade.

We'll also close Springvale Road between Wells and Pillars roads **overnight from 9pm from Saturday 6 February until Sunday 21 February**. See inside for more information.

We'll carry out most of these works during the day, **Monday to Friday between 7am and 7pm** and on **Saturdays between 7am and 3.30pm**. Some works may need to happen at night to minimise impacts on traffic and utility services, but we'll let you know in advance of works outside our normal hours.

### Construction impacts

We'll use trucks, cranes, excavators, piling rigs and other machinery to complete these works. You may experience some noise and vibration and be able to see machinery from time to time. We may also need to remove trees and vegetation where it's unavoidable.

We'll sometimes need to temporarily close lanes on local roads, reduce speed limits and detour pedestrian paths affected by our works.

We'll do our best to minimise our construction impacts and will continue to monitor noise and vibration levels during the works.

# UPCOMING DISRUPTIONS



## Springvale Road

We'll need to close Springvale Road between Wells and Pillars roads between **9pm and 5.30am on weeknights** and between **9pm and 7am on weekends** from **Saturday 6 February until Sunday 21 February** while we asphalt new lanes.

Detours will be in place via Wells and Governor roads **between 9pm and 5.30am on weeknights**, and **9pm and 7am on weekends**.

You'll still be able to access the Mornington Peninsula Freeway when travelling southbound on Springvale Road, or via Wells Road and Thames Promenade.

The bus stops on Springvale Road at Pillars Road and Waterways Boulevard will be temporarily closed in both directions while we work.



## Centre Dandenong Road

We'll be closing Centre Dandenong Road between Boundary and Tootal roads from **8pm Friday 26 February to 5am Monday 1 March 2021** while we lift the new bridge beams into place.

Detours will be in place via Old Dandenong Road or Lower Dandenong Road.

Pedestrian access along Centre Dandenong Road will also close at night between **11pm and 9am** during this time. Detours will be in place via Howard and Lower Dandenong roads.

The bus stops on Centre Dandenong Road near Boundary and Tootal roads will be temporarily closed in both directions while we work.

There may be minor traffic delays while we complete the work so please allow extra time for your journey.
